



PAY CHART Deputy Sheriff Lateral

The chart below represents the typical hourly base pay for Deputy Sheriff Lateral. The left side of the chart represents your classification. The top of the chart represents your step in pay.

Deputy Sheriff steps two through eight are based on a 42.5 hour-work week. Generally, it takes 5 1/2 years from step 2 to step 8.

The Pay Scale is approximate and reflects the hourly and annual salary for each step.
